iPHONE/iPAD PHOTOGRAPHY THE APPS

Apps generally fall into one of 4 general categories.

- 1. Assistance apps: Apps like a flashlight, Lightrac (which shows you where the sun will rise and set and the moon will rise and set. Also times.) Water level helps you level photos etc: on the wall. Photosync allows you to sync photos from the iphone to the ipad. Also Apps Gone Free lists 7-12 apps every day that normally cost money; but for that day only they are free. Need to check every day. For photographers: Lens Lab and DOF Master help determine hyperfocal distance.
- 2. Camera apps: These are apps that are different cameras to use on the phone
 A. Camera + (Not camera plus) Has a nice slider to expand the zoom. Also has separate focus and exposure buttons (unlike the native camera where they are attached together). Also gives you your ISO, fstop and shutter speed. Has a burst and stabilizer options.
- B. Smug mug Has grid lines, stabilization, golden mean, burst plus some effects
- C. Slow Shutter Cam: Has flashlight, can set shutter speed. Best used with a tripod.
 - D. Pro HDR; Takes two photos and averages them to give you full range.
- E. Hipstamatic: Takes square photos and has a variety of lenses and films to choose from.
- F. ilightning: Takes a photo when lightning flashes. However, sensitive to other moving lights, like cars and reflections on signs.
- G. BluxPro: Can control white balance (temperature), has filter effects, HDR, macro, snow, rain, and high key settings.
- H. ProCamera: Has histogram, shows shutter speed and ISO, white balance adjustment, 4:3 or 3:2 aspect ratio setting, composition grid, level and self timer.
 - I. Monopix: Black and white, has different scenes.
- 3. Effect or Filter Apps: These add all kinds of different effects.
