### RawTherapee

- Runs on Windows, Mac and Linux
- Lots of the basic functions needed. Can export raw files that you cannot read with some to a format your other app can read.
- More of a learning curve with this one.
- Open source

## Darktable

- More learning curve.
- Plugins available.
- Can do masking.
- Open source.

#### Paint.net

- No raw, only jpg.
- Windows or mac.
- Can do more creative things with it as it is based on the old windows Paint program.

#### PhotoPosPro

- Pro or novice interface.
- Was Kevin's favorite but not the one he regularly uses.

Lightzone - Kevin uses this program 95-98% of the time.

- Runs on Windows, Mac or Linux.
- Lots of YouTube videos to learn from.
- Does gradients and has Brush tools.
- Stacks styles that you can apply and opens a new panel to modify the style.
- Can also change opacity of styles.
